NEW YORK CITY - famous places

| THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING | This place is called "The Crossroads of the World"; known as the world's most visited tourist attraction (39 million visitors every year). It's also the site of the annual New Year's Eve ball drop. On December 31, 1907, a ball signifying New Year's Day was first dropped there and there has been the main New Year's celebration in NY City ever since. |
| THE STATUE OF LIBERTY | A multi-purpose indoor arena. Opened on February 11, 1968, it is the longest active major sporting facility in NY and also the third busiest music arena in the world. It is the oldest arena in the NHL, and the second oldest in the NBA. |
| CENTRAL PARK | A neoclassical sculpture on Liberty Island in New York Harbor, designed by Frédéric Bartholdi in 1886. It was a gift to the US from the people of France. The female figure represents Libertas, the Roman goddess of freedom with a torch and a tabula ansata (a tablet meaning the law) - the date of the American Declaration of Independence, July 4, 1776 is inscribed on it. A broken chain lies at her feet. The statue has become an icon of freedom and of the USA. |
| TIMES SQUARE | A 102-story skyscraper, 381 meters high (antenna spire 443.2 m). It was the world's tallest building for 40 years, from its completion in 1931 until construction of the World Trade Center's North Tower in 1972. Nowadays, it's the third tallest completed skyscraper in the United States, an American cultural icon. It is designed in the Art Deco style and is known as one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. Over the years, more than thirty people have committed suicide from the top of the building. |

MADISON SQUARE GARDEN

Opened in 1857; extends on 3.41 km² of city-owned land. In 1858, the landscape designer and writer Frederick Law Olmsted and the English architect Calvert Vaux won a design competition to improve and expand this place. Construction continued also during the American Civil War, and was completed in 1873. It was pronounced a National Historic Landmark in 1962, receiving about 35 million visitors every year. It has its own New York City Police Department precinct. In 2005, safety measures managed to reduce the number of crimes there to fewer than one hundred per year (from about 1,000 in the early 1980s).
