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Název DUM: Předpřítomný čas, křížovka - oblečení **Vzdělávací oblast:** Jazyk a jazyková komunikace

Druh učebního materiálu: pracovní list

Klíčová slova: křížovka, oblečení, předpřítomný čas, ever/never, nepravidelná slovesa

Anotace: V tomto pracovním listu nejprve žáci luští křížovku – podle definic dopisují do křížovky oblečení. Druhá část pracovního listu je zaměřena na fixaci předpřítomného času. Žáci popisují podle tabulky zkušenosti dotyčných osob, poté vedou ve dvojici rozhovory – ptají se na zkušenosti, používají *ever/never*. Dále uspořádají zpřeházená slova do vět a v posledním cvičení hledají ve slovníku *past participle* méně známých sloves, které pak doplní do vět – rozšiřují si tak slovní zásobu


