Anotace: Cvičení vytvořené v programu Hot Potatoes slouží k celkovému zopakování a fixaci učiva o minulém čase prostém a průběhovém. Úkolem žáků je doplnit do volných políček sloveso ze závorky v jednom z minulých časů. Opakují tak rovněž minulý čas nepravidelných sloves a procvičují čtení s porozuměním, kdy musí správně pochopit kontext věty, aby byli schopni rozhodnout, který z časů použít. Cvičení obsahuje celkem 30 vět a žáci musí doplnit 73 tvarů sloves. V průběhu cvičení ši po konsi si žáci plostatelník a poství své odpovědi.
